Sexual assaults taking place on public school premises have tripled in number since the end of World War II!

This was revealed in the 1955 revised report of the National Association on Morality Standards in the Public Schools. The report also showed the following:

In 1954 there were 1,233 attempted assaults of a sexual nature by students in schools throughout the U.S. This was an increase of 800 over attempted assaults in 1946.

Teachers were apprehended in assault crimes 363 times in 1954. Only 78 teachers were involved in such attempts 8 years before.

There has been a 76% increase in illegitimate births among high school students since 1950. 123 newborn infants were ditched in school lavatories or elsewhere on school premises during 1954 as compared to only 17 during 1949.

The ABCs of sex are fast replacing the Three Rs as the shocking "lesson for today" in schools around the nation. In-school sex-sessions are on the increase and often teachers participate along with students!



from teachers and students in schools from coast to coast. Names are withheld to protect them from retribution:


"Students think nothing of necking, petting and indulging in even freer sex-play in the corridors between classes. Often it is carried over, in the form of surreptitious pinches and caresses, right in the classroom!" —Miami High School teacher.

disturbed over the sex and violence of their school life than either their parents or teachers. 4-H clubs, Scout organizations, Ys and PALs have long been the most potent force against juvenile delinquency.

Now students are forming clubs which aim directly at combatting specific situations. In a mid-western high school some girls were outraged by stories of non-virgin clubs in their vicinity. They formed the "Kiss-Stop!" club.

These girls feel that affection between teen-agers can be adequately expressed by a kiss. Anything further than that means trouble. Among their aims are putting end to necking and petting sessions, putting dignity in dress ahead of sex, and making people realize that juveniles are junior citizens and not sexcrazy riff-raff.

The "Strongmen" have been formed by a group of teen-age boys in the South. The movement, which is spreading fast, extracts a vow from male members that they will remain virgins until marriage.

The president of the Memphis chapter has this to say. "Most young fellows feel they have to have sex to prove they are men. An adolescent really proves his manhood when he has enough respect for his own body to refrain from illicit sex relations. The teens are the time for us to study and learn, and the school-room should be a hallowed hall rather than an ivied brothel room."


Youth movements are waging a strong fight against schoolroom sex, but 'they can't do it alone. They need the help of parents, educators, and community leaders.
