## Depression Preventatives

After eighteen months' study, a group of more than 50 leading industrialists and economists listed the conditions which must prevail during periods of recovery and prosperity to help prevent depressions. Their report, sponsored by the National Association of Manufacturers, urges: abandonment of government activity which prevents the functioning of private enterprise; recognition by government that regulation of business does not justify direct control of the facilities of business; moderate and equitable taxes; and restriction of government expenditures and debt.
