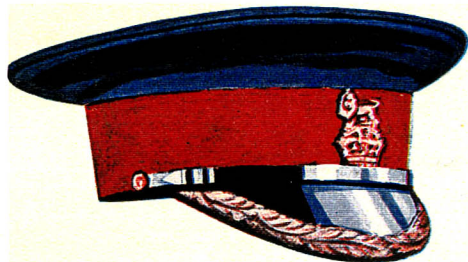

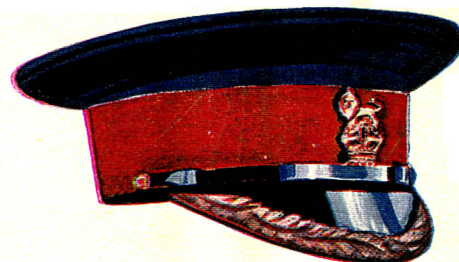

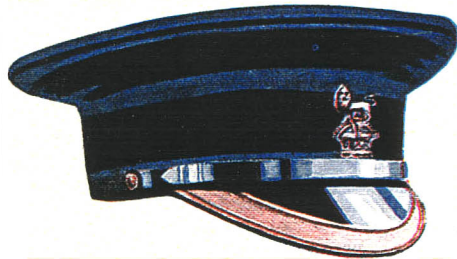
AIDE-DE-CAMP TO THE KING.

Embroidered Peak.



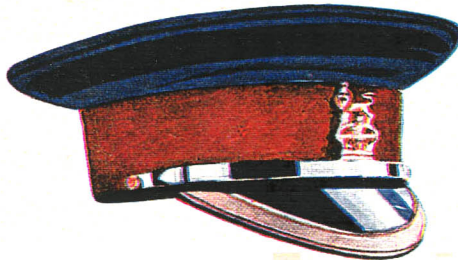
EQUERRY TO THE KING.

Embroidered Peak.



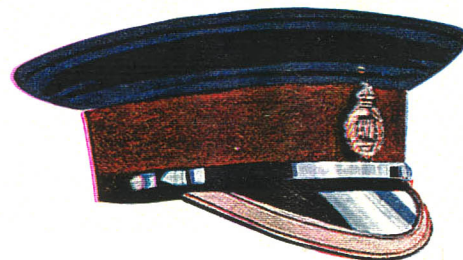
STAFF OFFICER.
