## GERMANY'S PLOT TO STEAL THE PEACE

Late last October, a man arrived in London who a few days previously had escaped from Germany. He told agents of the British Secret Service that the Germans are already thinking in terms of a third world war and are confident of a victory in it, having written off the winning of the present war.

The German General Staff now believes that its big mistake in this war was leaving England last on its agenda of victims. Members of the staff are agreed not to repeat that error in the third world war which they are now preparing.

The German technique of "organizing defeat" for the purpose of trying again later when the chances for ultimate victory are better, is being demonstrated now with unmatched effrontery.
