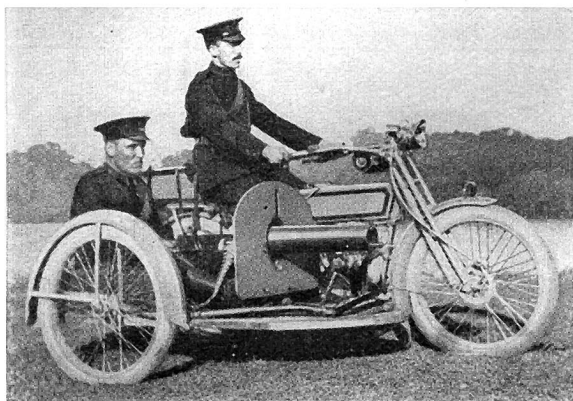

An interesting adaptation of the motorcycle to military uses has been

made by employing it as a light artillery vehicle. An example of this is illustrated by the accompanying photograph which shows a machine gun mounted on a sidecar chassis. An artillery corps equipped in this manner is able to travel at the regular marching pace one moment and dash ahead to some distant point at a high rate of speed the next. The machine is American built, but was invented by a Canadian militia officer. It was used in maneuvers at Ft. Osborne, Winnipeg, some time ago, where its wide range of action was demonstrated.
