


MOTOREARS

Wool in the cuffs of 21 men's suits will make one army uniform.








The nylon and silk from 136 pairs of stockings will make one army parachute.

The shellac in one phonograph record will make a signal flare.


BICYCLES

clubs will make 30 hand grenades.




RUGS
